JUNIOR CHURCH / SUNDAY SCHOOL REMODEL AND REVEAL!








Because He Said So

I bet we can all remember our frustrated parents put an end to a conversation with something like "because I said so, that's why..." As curious and/or restless and frustrated children, that was not the answer we were seeking but we knew it was time to stop asking. I have heard that some people have trouble thinking or God as "Father" because of issues they had with their earthly father. Humans are far from perfect and if you don't believe that, well just ask my wife or children. I understand why people might have trouble with the concept. However, Our Heavenly Father is perfect. Jesus Christ created everything on earth, was born in the flesh, yet lived a sinless life and then died to take the punishment that we all deserve so that we imperfect beings can be made right with our perfect Heavenly Father. God - Our Father, deserves our complete trust and faith to say the least.

1st Peter 3:15 But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect. Jesus Christ is Lord and savior to all that believe and give their lives to trusting in Him. We know this because he said so but there is so much more. The Bible contains all truth but the truth is not revealed simply in the words. When Jesus asked the disciples who He was, Peter answered that Jesus is "Messiah, Son of God." Peter had spent three years with Jesus. He had seen first-hand, the miracles and heard His miraculous teaching. 
